

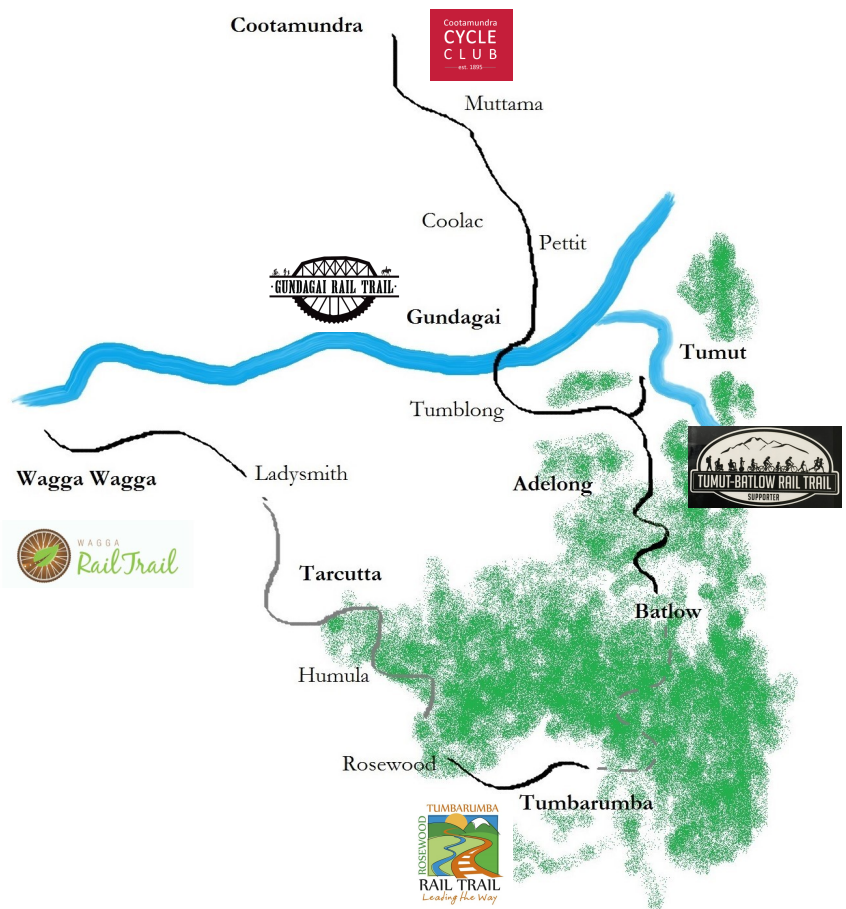
Eastern Riverina Rail Trails

Communities across the Eastern Riverina have been looking to embrace the development of Rail Trails since the early 2000's. Wanting the economic and social benefits Rail Trails bring for their communities, a number of Rail Trail supporter groups have been formed over the last decade.

In the Eastern Riverina, four trails are being actively investigated by councils and community groups and one is under construction. The proposed and under construction rail trails include two disused branch lines: Wagga Wagga—Tumbarumba branch line and the Cootamundra—Batlow branch line, which fall across three Council areas (Cootamundra Gundagai Regional Council, Snowy Valleys Council, Wagga Wagga City Council).

While each proposal will individually return significant economic and social benefits to those communities, the linking of these projects will create a major primary regional tourism attraction of international appeal, benefiting the broader regional economy.



Eastern Riverina Rail Trail Alliance

The Alliance consists of the Tumbarumba Rail Trail, Gundagai Rail Trail Supporters Group, Tumut Batlow Rail Trail and Cootamundra—Coolac Rail Trail.

The aim of the Alliance is to advocate for and promote Rail Trails in the Eastern Riverina as a combined regional product.
